



CLASSIFIED ACCESS DEBRIEFING

You are now being debriefed from access to classified information. However, the "Classified Information Nondisclosure Agreement" (DD Form 312) that you signed when you were given access continues to legally bind you to your responsibility to protect classified information from unauthorized disclosure.

Even though you are no longer authorized access, you are required to report any unauthorized disclosure of classified information or any attempt to solicit classified information from you. If you become aware of the above activities, you should immediately report the incident to the FBI, the local DSS field office, or the security staff of the nearest DoD contractor. Be advised that United States Criminal laws continue to exist that could be used to prosecute you for criminal violation if you were to wrongfully disclose classified information.

After you leave, ERC will continue to play a vital role in the defense of our nation. If you disclose details of the classified work being accomplished by ERC, you could degrade our contribution to the national defense and could possibly place the lives of U.S. citizens in jeopardy. Even though debriefed from access to classified information, you still play a vital role in the protection of national security information. Good luck in your future endeavors and please remain as conscience of your security responsibilities as you were as an ERC employee.
